I. Announcements

A. Update from Safety Nets

a. Dr. Levy

- i. Health Department commitment to 3 area Safety Net Clinics
 1. HD safety net
 2. Mobile Outreach Clinic
 - a. Will allow them access to staff from AAMRC
 3. SWAG center
 - a. Primarily staffed by Alachua Area Medical Reserve Corp (AAMRC)
 - i. AAMRC has 20 practitioners & 600 other volunteers
 - ii. Primarily instituted for disaster relief
 - iii. Can't work at HD until they are trained on the statewide EMR system.
 - b. Perhaps there is grant that will allow for some paid staff
- ii. RTS
 1. Ran by the City of Gainesville
 - a. County pays for County routes



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- b. City pays for City routes
- c. RTS considers any destination within 1500 ft (.28 miles) accessible
 - i. All safety nets are within this parameter-except Westside Samaritan.
 - 1. Option 1- Can pay for a van to provide transportation \$50/hr. (This is the already subsidized fee that Westside Samaritan would have to pay.)
 - 2. Option 2- Petition for a stop to be added on new route that is proposed for Gainesville-Jonesville connection.
- d. Solstice Labs- Can't get RTS to turn in because of limited bus maneuverability
 - i. Can require them to put in sidewalks
- e. RAHMA Clinic-
 - i. Not meeting requirements to get bus to turn around
 - ii. Planning a route on 13th Street
 - 1. Taking UF students to Lake Robert
 - 2. Mosque is also at this location (added reason for a stop)

b. Health Department

- i. Two new services
 - 1. Breast and Cervical Screening (ongoing service)
 - a. Patient allowed one screening a year
 - b. Administered through We Care
 - c. Must be 50-64 years old
 - d. Can self enroll
 - 2. Colon Screening
 - a. No risk factors evident; no family history
 - b. Doctor has a checklist and put attest to everything on the list
 - c. Limited funding for the program
- ii. We Care
 - 1. When are the office hours
 - 2. When and what kind of translation assistance is needed
 - 3. Training to safety nets so we can prescreen

c. Robin Lewy-Rural Women

- i. Use the 'Migrant Clinicians Network's Health Net program
 - 1. Multi-lingual



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2. Provides one number for patients to call for support
3. Helps with continuity of care
4. For anyone that is pregnant or has a chronic illness

d. Candice King (ACORN Clinic)

- i. SNP group coordinate with elected officials
 1. Start with Randy Wells
 2. How do we educate city/county on what we are doing; our objective
 - a. How we fit with the Affordable Care Act
 3. Can Well Florida help?
 4. Candice take the lead on this effort
- ii. Event to honor area physicians
 1. Done every few years
 2. Contribute to recruitment and education
 3. Fundraising opportunity
 - a. Engage PR Students
 - b. Can we get Randy Bautista(?) interested

e. Good Samaritan

- i. Dispensary can accept prescriptions for any non-narcotic drugs
- ii. Needs pharmacy interns
 1. HD clinic can use interns as well

f. Mobile Outreach Clinic-

- i. Care Coordination
 1. MOC piloting a program
 2. How can other Safety Nets partner/share MOC idea
- ii. SharePoint
 1. Secure
 2. Requires users to have GatorLink
 3. Central location to coordinated information regarding SNP group & share patient info if necessary.
